

New Online Training

Scoutmaster & Assistant Scoutmaster Training, Sea Scout and Merit Badge Counselor Training are now available online at the BSA Learn Center of my.scouting.org.

*Please note to be trained you must also complete Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS).

Course Structure

Each of the online courses listed above consist of three modules. Each module will have anywhere from 2 to 13 individual classes. Each class will take anywhere from 2 minutes to 17 minutes to complete. You must complete all three modules to complete the training for any position. **However, you can take these individual class at your leisure, starting and stopping as time permits.** Crew Board of Reviews is a single module of only two class for a total of 26 minutes.

To take any of these online leader position training courses login to your my.scouting account. Be sure your current scout id number is on your profile.

- Click on Menu.
- Click on My Dashboard.
- Click on Training Center.

Select the program you wish to take, Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, etc.

Click on the Leader Position Specific Training you wish to take. This will take you to the BSA Learn Center.

Click on Course Catalog and select the courses you wish to take.

When finished go back to the top of the page menu and select My Learning. This will bring up all the courses you have selected. Click on each course to begin working. Your progress will be recorded as you complete each class and module. Remember you can start and stop as needed.

When you have completed a course the system will automatically update your training in the system. Many of the individual classes are repeated for the various positions in each program. For instance, if you complete the online training for Den Leader you will also have completed 19 of the 26 individual classes for Cubmaster. You do not need to retake a class once completed. The situation is the same for all of the program positions.

To be considered **TRAINED** for your position you can take either these online courses or one of the classroom courses offered throughout the council. If you need assistance please contact your District Training Chairman.
