- Meet at Stony Ford Canoe Ramp and drop off scouts @ 7:00 AM. Cars may then be taken to Columbia Woods where a bus will be available to return drivers to Stoney Ford.
- All canoeists **MUST HAVE CURRENT** (within 12 months) BSA SWIMMER CERTIFICATION.
- Registration by unit, At least one Adult per 10 Scouts. **See Leaders guide for Cost**
- Bring your own Canoes / Kayaks (paddles and lifejackets) or reserve rental canoes for an additional fee (see Leaders' Guide) Number of canoes available may be limited.
- Bring meals, extra clothes in waterproof bags, Sunscreen.
- Camp at Columbia Woods (w/Friday Night April 22 camping option!) **No Ground Fires!**
- Optional 5 mile Hike opportunity (instead of Saturday Canoe)
- Optional **Sunday** Canoe trip for more advanced scout canoers from Columbia Woods to Historic Isle a la Cache (12mi)
